LUBBOCK, Texas (November 30, 2010) – Jehovah's Witnesses announce the start of their Texas 27-A and 27-B Circuit Assembly, Saturday and Sunday, December 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at the Lubbock Memorial Civic Center, 1501 Mac Davis Lane. Doors open at 8am, and the program will be from 9:30am to 4:30pm. The congregations visiting Lubbock will be Spanish-speaking groups from Odessa, Midland, San Angelo, Abilene and surrounding West Texas communities. The program is a Bible-based program where individuals and families come together to worship. The entire program is free and open to the general public, with no collections solicited.

“There will be a number of Bible-based discussions, interviews, demonstrations and baptisms that will help ourselves and our families cope with life in this world such as it is, and still maintain our integrity to our God,” said Brian Waller, Contract Representative and Local Minister of Jehovah's Witnesses.

The Circuit Assembly will bring an approximate attendance of 1,400 people to Lubbock, with an economic impact of approximately \$92,322.
